Thus, once again this year, day after day, we are now about to celebrate Christmas. As always, we see the lights appearing on the streets, we begin to think about presents and maybe even of holidays. All things, let us face it, appearing so singular and strange that at first might seem a sort of pious legend to console us in our troubled life. A myth was born two thousand years ago, spread over the centuries, coming up to us.

This is how many think of it today; unfortunately, they thus deny all the good that comes from faith. It is, however, not a myth as shown by countless studies and researches throughout the course of the Christian story; one after the other demonstrated how those extraordinary stories that the evangelists tell us are certainly credible and can therefore indeed fully belong to the history of humanity, they are even its very foundation. It is clear that if all this was true, it even takes greater importance, especially in this more and more troubled time in which many difficulties overlap and entwine each other.

It is also clear that for all this, today not only our faith should not diminish, but rather must become even more secure and profound to enable us to draw from it the strength and light we need to live these coming complicated and difficult years. On a personal and intimate way, in the depths of our hearts in an open and continuous dialogue with the God who chose to become like us to show us His love. Also outwardly, we should not be afraid to express our Christian belief by continuing to live with simplicity and sweetness, without evasiveness, neither complexes nor fears

# A dwelling in Paradise

The old movie «A dwelling in Paradise» tells the story of a boy who, after the death of his mother, is totally abandoned, forgotten and haunted. Desperate and heartbroken on a cold December evening, he went to the tomb of his mother seeking for solace. There he laid himself down on top of the grave and wept, calling his mother's name, longing for the warmth of her maternal heart. Tired, he eventually fell asleep. Then he dreamed of a ladder that rose from earth to heaven, and comforted by that vision, he climbed the steps, reaching dizzying heights. Looking up, he saw the smiling face of his mother. Then he saw that she was tossing a ball of silver thread that came bouncing along the steps towards him. The boy grabbed the shiny thread, holding it tightly in his hands and moved upward, higher and higher. It was such a gorgeous sight. At the highest point of the scale his mother was waiting. He moved towards her and she kept her son in her spirit, embracing him with kisses and soothing him... When he wakened up the youngster found himself in a strange room; half-frozen he had been transported to the infirmary. He recovered and went along his life, which was difficult and hard as before; somehow it did not seem so hard and cruel anymore as the smile of his mother always hovered over him; the warmth of her maternal heart continued. His mother accompanied and assisted him from heaven.

It is a beautiful story, a moving film, but I never could write a more moving chronicle about the marvelous day of Faith and Grace that we have experienced on December 8 in Fontanelle.

The pilgrims, the first of the new **HOLY YEAR**, crowded in Fontanelle in the early morning when in the sky «the morning star» still shone alongside the crescent moon. They filled the streets and gardens, the chapel, the stations of the Cross, the morning procession. They were in many during the Marian prayer and the solemn Mass. There was a long queue before the confessionals, the holy Scale, the Source and the tub. Numerous pilgrims attended the Eucharistic banquet, the Hour of Universal Grace and the offering of the new rosary of nacre and silver filigree in the hands of Rosa Mystica, Mother of the Church and our Mother. And in the afternoon, which like the morning was bathing in a tepid sunlight, the feast of the Immaculate continued with a renewed devotion of all the pilgrims during the Adoration, the Rosary and in the confessionals. The solemn Mass was celebrated by Don Marco, the Bishop's Delegate. When he closed the feast with a floral tribute to the Virgin in the form of a basket full of white, red and yellow roses, in the dark of night the glowing star was indicating and still will indicate forever all the places of the Divine Mercy. On December 8 of this Holy Year which has just been started, each of us together with the pilgrims were weaving a magnificent tapestry with the silver thread we received as a gift from our Mother of Heaven; it is a tapestry telling over and over again about the goodness of the Virgin in this blessed place. Like in the story of the boy, we also are clutching the silver thread, which is the devotion to Our Lady and climb the steps of the staircase that rises from the earth to heaven.

May the days of the Holy Year of Mercy, pass through our fingers like the nacre beads of a rosary linked by a thread of silver filigree under the gaze of the most tender of mothers: the Virgin Mary.

That is our wish and our prayer for the coming Christmas and New Year.
